OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Selection of Cities in Round 2 of the Smart Cities All India Challenge.

The Competent Authority has approved the list of top 27 cities (Annexure I) for implementation of proposals sent by the shortlisted Smart Cities in the main Round 2 of the Smart Cities Challenge process.

2. Further, remaining cities (Annexure – II) which have not achieved the cut off score, will require to compete in Round 3 of the Competition. Round 3 will start from 1st January 2017 and cities will have to submit their revised Smart City Proposals (SCPs) by 31st March 2017.

3. In terms of Para 12.2 of the Mission Guidelines, an amount of Rs. 194 crore per winning city is approved after adjusting the advance of Rs. 2 crore already released. The release is subject to establishment of Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) and meeting other conditions.

4. The State Governments are requested to establish the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) in terms of Para 10 of the Mission Guidelines under intimation to this Ministry so that funds could be released at the earliest.
